Figure 1. Who Does vs Who Should Ask Patients About Cannabis Use

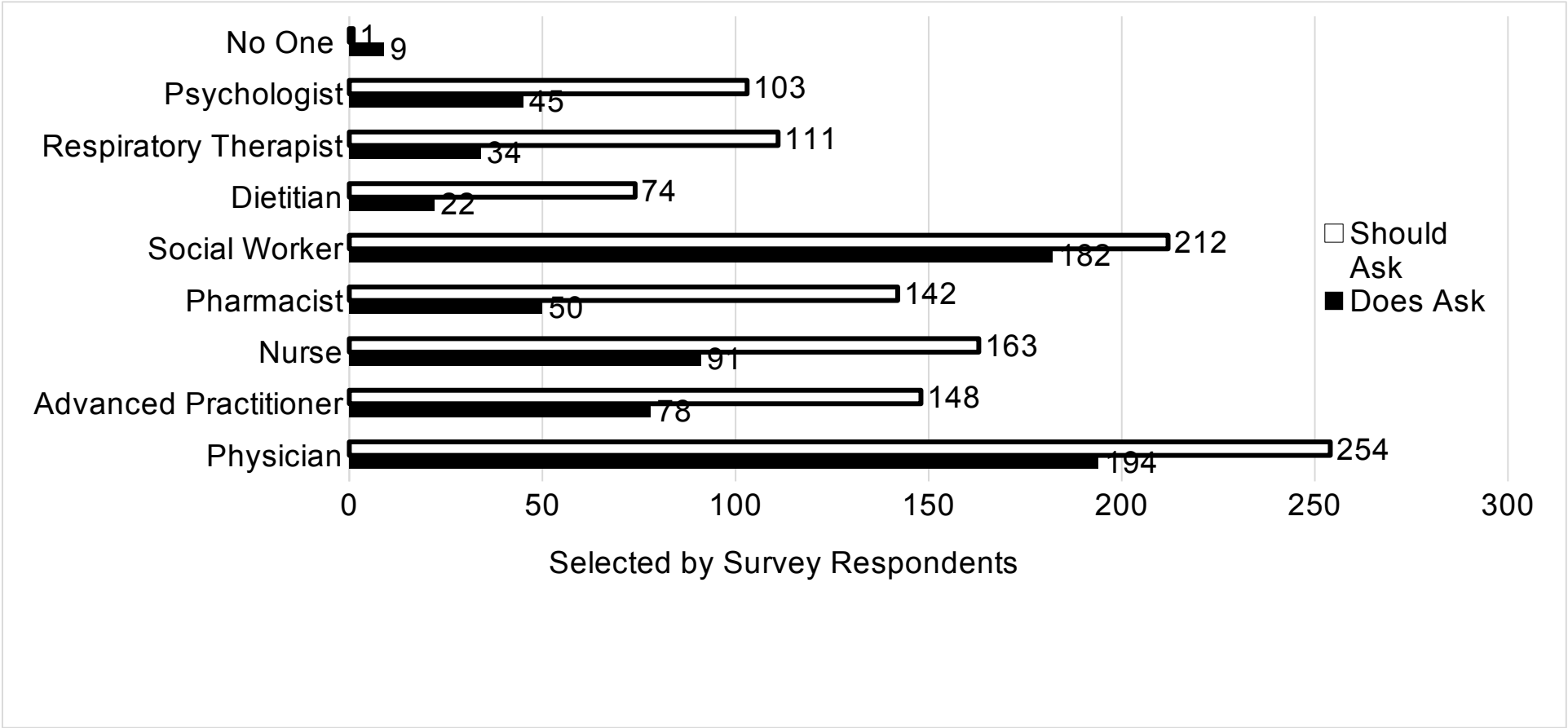


Figure 2. Where Is MEDICAL or RECREATIONAL Cannabis Use Documented?

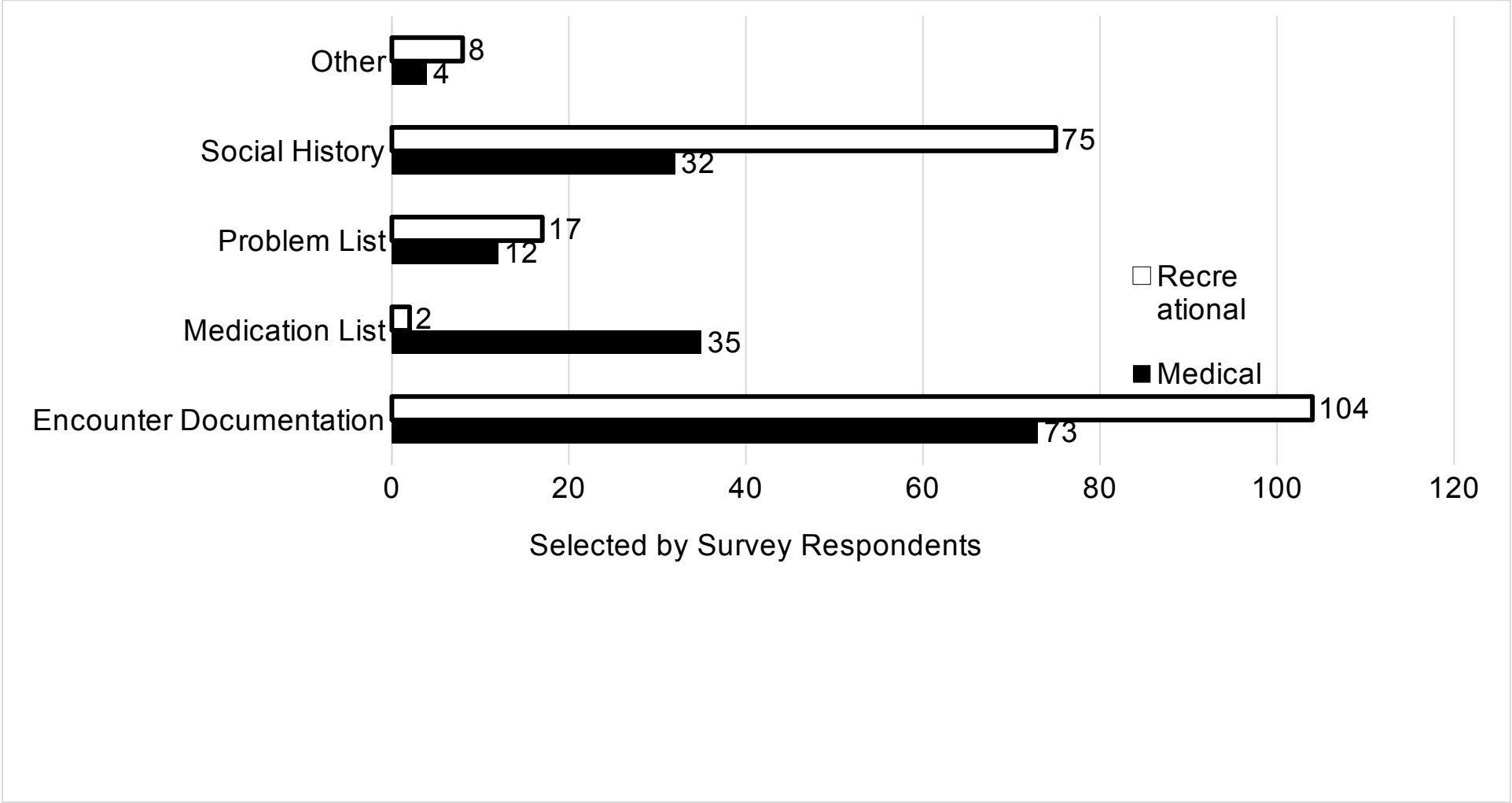


Figure 3. What Is the Primary Reason You Do Not Document MEDICAL or RECREATIONAL Cannabis Use In The Medical Record?

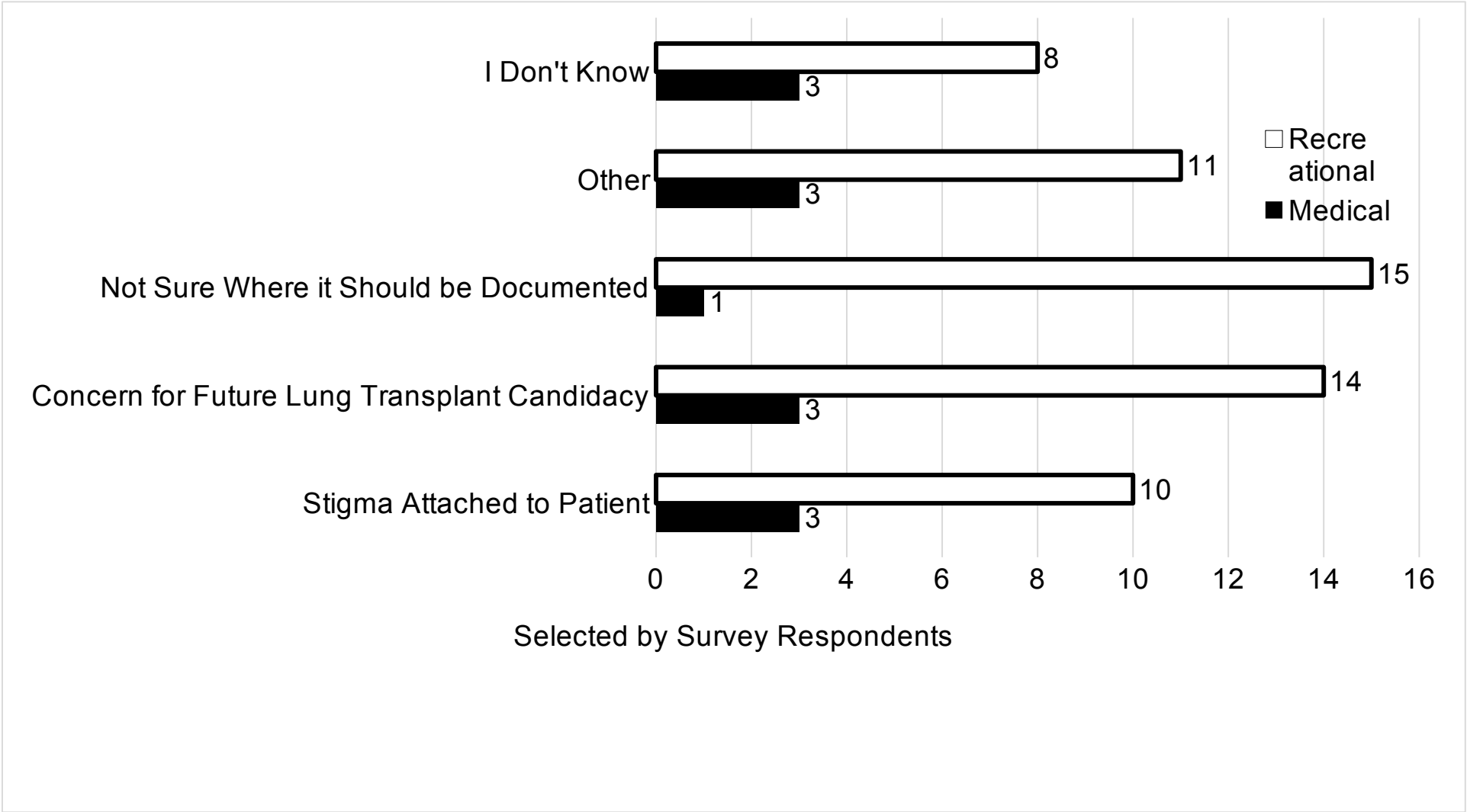


Figure 4. In What Areas Would You Like To See Educational Materials About Cannabis And CF?

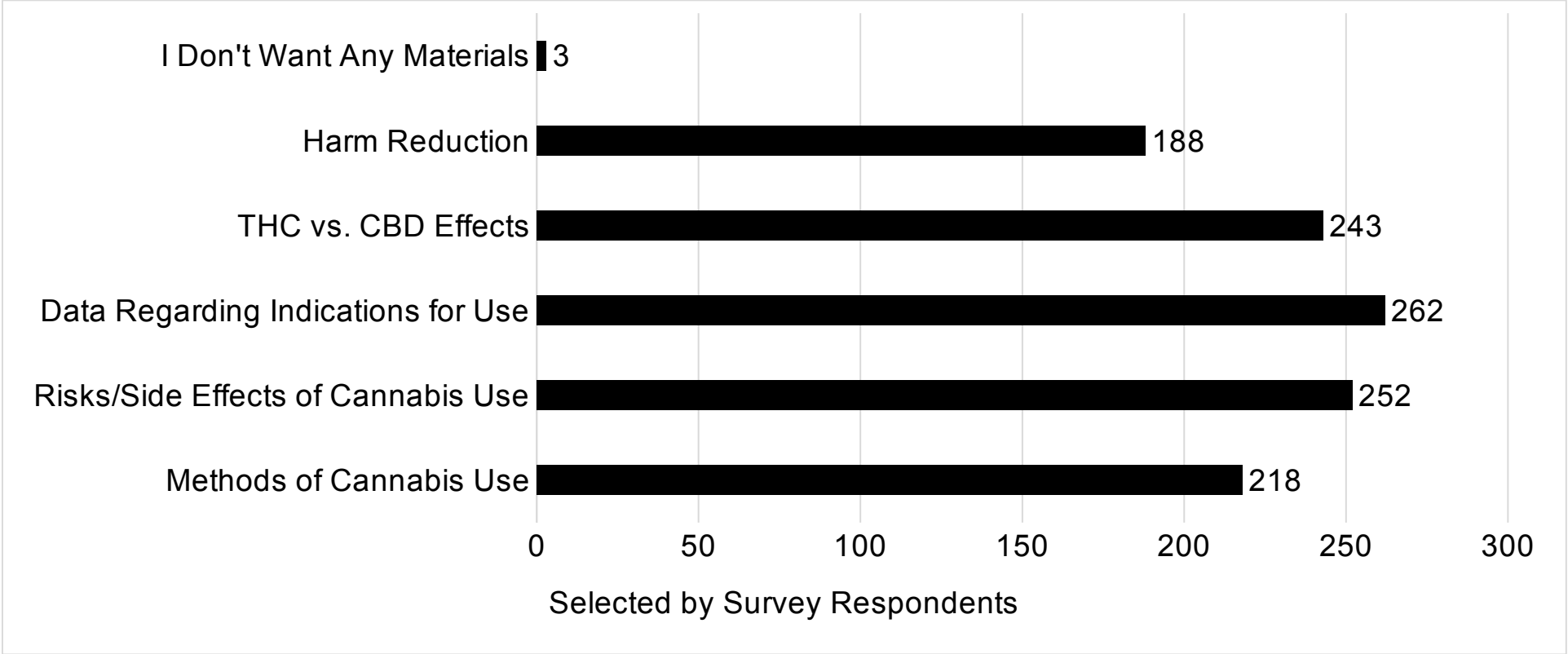


Figure 5. What Are the Indications for Which You Would Consider Advocating For CANNABIS or CANNABIDIOL (CBD)?

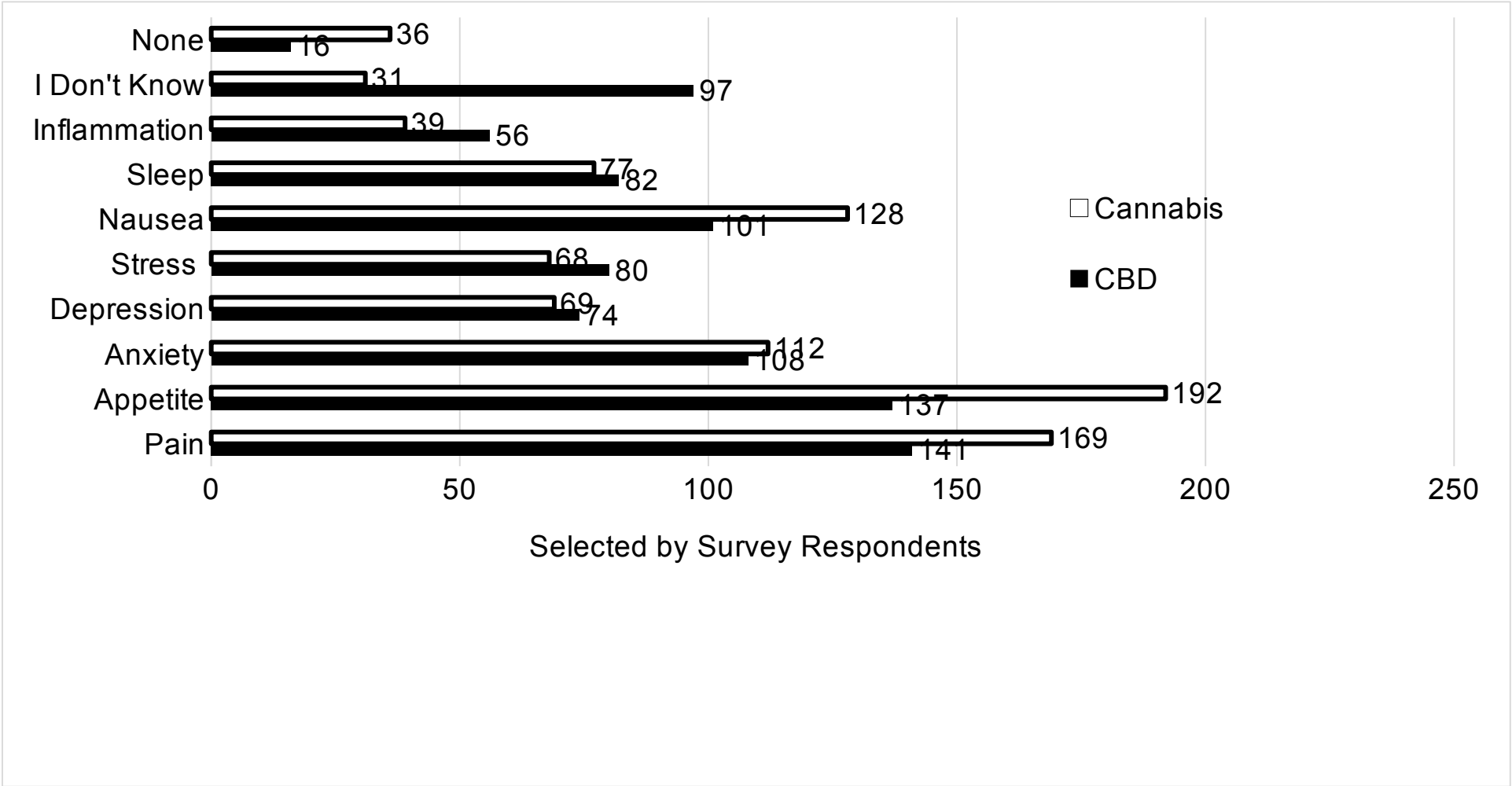


Figure 6. For What Reasons Would You NOT Support Cannabis Use?
